

Policy on Discrimination and Accommodations for Individuals with Disabilities

Early Childhood Resource Center does not discriminate against individuals with disabilities in its application procedures, hiring, advancement, discharge, compensation, training, or other terms, conditions, and privileges of contractual agreement.

Early Childhood Resource Center will conduct its affairs in compliance with Section 504 of the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Ohio Human Rights Act.

Early Childhood Resource Center will make every effort to provide reasonable accommodations to individuals with disabilities so that they can participate in virtual or in-person training sessions. A training participant who requires a reasonable accommodation should notify the trainer prior to the start of each session. All accommodation requests will be evaluated; accommodation may be denied if it would impose an undue hardship on Early Childhood Resource Center.
