Registration

- After the deadline, registration will be accepted via telephone, if seats are available.
- **Walk-in registration will not be accepted.**
- Classes may be cancelled due to low enrollment or weather conditions.
- We do not provide in-service forms. All credit will be awarded in the Ohio Professional Registry.
