### Training Policies

#### Registration

- Registration is required for all classes.

  - Your OPIN number is required at the time of registration.
- To register, visit [registry.occrra.org](http://registry.occrra.org). Sign into your account and click the *Find Training* button on the left side. You can search by county, instructor, title, or training ID for the date range you are interested in. **For assistance, call 877-691-8521 to speak with a training and referral specialist.**
- After the deadline, registration will be accepted via telephone, if seats are available.
- Classes may be cancelled due to low enrollment or weather conditions.
- We do not provide in-service forms. All credit will be awarded in the Ohio Professional Registry.
